

VARIANCE FROM TDTA COMPETITION RULES FOR NIGHT TENNIS DIVISION ONE-

1.1 Teams

The number of players in each team to be determined by subcommittee prior to commencement of each competition.

1.2 Starting Time

To be determined by subcommittee prior to commencement of each competition.

1.3 Match Play Order

To be determined by subcommittee prior to commencement of each competition.

1.4 Courts and Balls

To be determined by subcommittee prior to commencement of each competition.

1.5 Match Fees

To be collected by a person duly appointed by the subcommittee.

Order of Play

3.1 Team Order

Before the match begins the home team will nominate its players first in order on the result sheet. Players must be played in the order of their **individual grading**.

6.3 Team Members

a) A team member graded the **lowest individual grade(4)** may play unlimited matches in a **same club lower Division** team. (In finals is subject to 7.4 Player Eligibility).

b) A team member may play a **lower grade**. (refer 6.3 a).

c) A team member may play **five** matches for another team or in a higher division.

d) Upon playing **six** matches in another team or a higher division a player cannot play in their original team or division.

6.4 Floating Reserves (a,b & d remain the same, e is additional).

c) A floating reserve may play **unlimited** matches for any team.

A floating reserve qualified to play finals for a team must become a financial member of that teams club prior to the finals match.

e) A floating reserve must pay their Club Membership fees & Tennis NSW or affiliated registration fees before the commencement of their third match otherwise the team they play in will lose all points for any matches that player plays in.

Finals-

7.2 Court Location

Semi-finals & Grand Finals shall be played at a venue determined by the subcommittee.

7.4 Player Eligibility (b, & d remain the same).

a) A nominated team player or floating reserve must play a minimum of **three** matches for the team in the scheduled rounds to be eligible to play in finals.

A nominated team member & floating reserve upon playing **six** matches in a division is not eligible to play finals in a lower division.

c) If players eligible under rule 7.4(a), are not available, **same club** players with the **lowest individual grading(4)** in that Division or from a lower Division may be used subject to the approval of the subcommittee.

7.5 Order of Play

a) In finals the team captains will exchange their order of play confidentially & have the names recorded on the result sheet before the match begins.

Players must play in the order of their **individual grading**.
